- **PMSR with the Added Credential in Reconstructive Rearfoot/Ankle Surgery.**
- Fully approved by the Council on Podiatric Medical Education.
- Two or three first year slots open per year (eight residents in training per year). Three PGY1 slots will be available for the 2017-18 training year.
- Stipend: PGY1: \$46,339 PGY2: \$48,914 PGY3: \$52,132
- 13 days of annual leave and 13 days of sick leave provided.
- Health and life insurance available.
- Surgical case participation in all training years with over 50 surgical attendings.
- Meets residency training requirements for Board Qualification/Certification in:
 - √ Foot surgery by the ABFAS.
 - √ Reconstructive Rearfoot/Ankle Surgery by the ABFAS.
 - √ Podiatric Medicine by the ABPM.
