Ribbon-Cutting Ceremony for Piscataway Veterans' Clinic

(Piscataway, NJ) – The Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) New Jersey Health Care System will hold an official ribbon-cutting ceremony for the new Piscataway Veterans' Community Based Outpatient Clinic (CBOC) on Tuesday, May 17 at 11 a.m. The new, larger CBOC opened in January of this year and replaces the smaller clinic formerly located in New Brunswick. The CBOC is located at 14 Wills Way, Building 4, in Piscataway and has plenty of free parking.

Ken Mizrach, Director of the VA New Jersey Health Care System, which oversees the CBOC, said, "We are excited to be offering our nation's heroes with the quality of health care services they so deserve." He added that the types of services available at the new site include "primary care in the new Patient Aligned Care Team model; women's health; expanded telehealth services; expanded social work services; and nutrition and psychiatry services." The CBOC is open from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday, excluding national holidays, and beginning this Wednesday, May 18, and every Wednesday thereafter, expanded hours will be available from 7 a.m. to 6:30 p.m.

United States Representative Frank Pallone (6th, NJ), a great supporter of VA services in New Jersey, will serve as the keynote speaker for the event. Attendees will include the Mayor of Piscataway, VA leadership from the New York/New Jersey Network of hospitals, Veteran Stakeholders and State Commanders of Veterans Service Organizations representing tens of thousands of Veterans throughout New Jersey.
